Student Unions Raise Concerns at University Agenda to impose alternative structures

Presidents from the two student unions at the University of Wollongong have held meetings today with administration bureaucrats to discuss the future of independent student representation.

Serious concerns have been raised in relation to the consultation process, the proposed timeframe and the intentions of the University Administration to impose its own representative structure on the students.

Independent autonomous student representation is an integral part of university life. The student unions are seeking clarification from the University to ensure that the unions will not be forcefully wound up by the University.

There will be a joint union media conference today with support from the South Coast Labor Council, the National Tertiary Education Union.
